### **Ferrari-Carano Pinot Grigio 2006 Russian River Valley**

The fuller-bodied examples (which are usually called Pinot Gris) are best with heavier summer foods, while the lighter wines (which are usually called Pinot Grigio) are good for sipping outside or with simpler fare. We would buy these young, though some of the bigger wines would age well for a few years.
